Executive Summary

OUR NATIONAL ACTION PLAN FOR RENEWING LIBERIA

After more than two decades of government mismanagement, civil war, and economic collapse, the Liberian people are now taking the first steps on the long road to recovery and sustained economic development. The "First 150 Days Action Plan" describes the initial actions that the Ellen Johnson Sirleaf Administration is taking, together with its partners, to begin the recovery process. The 150 Day Plan includes both actions and activities that are being completed and longer-term activities that are being initiated between the inauguration of President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf and the end of the fiscal year 2005/2006 on June 30, 2006.

The Government of Liberia's reconstruction and development strategy is based on four pillars, each of equal importance:

- 1. Expanding peace and security,
- 2. Revitalizing economic activity,
- 3. Rebuilding infrastructure and providing basic services, and
- 4. Strengthening governance and the rule of law.

Within each of these areas, the Government and its partners are taking many critical actions. The full list of actions is described in detail in the attached matrix. Some of the most important initiatives include the following:

1. Enhancing Peace and Security

The Government of Liberia (GOL), working in close collaboration with it partners, is:

- Building a capable and democratically accountable military force by completing the demobilization of ex-combatants, recruiting the first 2,000 new
 - Armed Forces of Liberia (AFL) troops, and initiating new military training programs.
- Strengthening national security institutions by initiating a reorganization of all security agencies, completing a national security review, beginning to de-

velop a national security plan, and demobilizing a significant portion of the Special Security Service (SSS).

- Beginning to strengthen the Liberian National Police Force (LNPF) by completing severance payments to retire police personnel, recruiting new personnel, and opening "Women and Child Protection Units" in 4 LNPF stations.
- Facilitating the return of 70,000 refugees from neighboring countries between January and June (75% more returnees than in all of 2005), reintegrating 50,000 Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) to their homes (from the original number of 314,000), and providing support to the returnees through health, water, training, and employment programs.

2. Revitalizing the Economy

The Government, working in close collaboration with its partners, is:

- Establishing sound financial management by submitting a recast balanced budget for 2005/06 and a complete balanced budget for 2006/07, introducing legislation to limit the power of the executive branch to change budget allocations, and establishing the extent of domestic arrears.
- Increasing revenues by introducing a computerized
 - "flag receipt" system, cracking down on customs fraud and other forms of tax evasion, and controlling expenditures through establishing a fully functioning cash management

system.

- Canceling non-compliant forestry and ports concessions, and is initiating a process to review the legality of all other concessions and contracts entered into during the tenure of the National Transitional Government of Liberia (NTGL).
- Preparing to sign a Letter of Intent with the International Monetary Fund and obtain IMF Board approval for a Staff Monitored Program—the first IMF program in Liberia for more than 20 years, as a first step towards dealing with the country's large external debt burden.
- Implementing the first steps of the Governance and Economic Management Assistance Program (GEMAP) to control financial abuse by placing internationally recruited financial controllers in the

Central Bank, National Port Authority, Forestry Development Authority, Roberts International Airport, and the Liberia Petroleum Refining Company.

Providing seeds and tools to at least 14,000 farmers, supplies for 1,800 fisherman, training assistance for agriculture for 2,000 ex-combatants, and food assistance for 16,000 families through foodfor-work programs.

3. Rebuilding Infrastructure and Providing Basic Services

The Government of Liberia, working in close collaboration with it partners, is:

- Beginning to rehabilitate several hundred kilometers of roads and bridges, including Fishtown to
 Harper, Ganta to Zwedru, Buchanan to River
 Cess, Phebe to Totota, and to repair certain roads
 in and around Monrovia.
 - Rehabilitating Zwedru High School, Greenville High School, 3 5 other schools around country, the Zwedru and Phebe hospitals, 39 clinics, and four community health facilities.

- Using \$1 million from improved tax collection to fund community projects of approximately \$10,000 each in 100 villages and districts across Liberia.
- Beginning to rebuild the electricity grid, with an initial goal of restoring power to some parts of Monrovia by July 26th, and expanding beyond as rapidly as possible thereafter.
- Revitalizing the national strategy to fight HIV/AIDS, providing 5,000 bed nets to households in high malaria endemic communities, and providing tuberculosis drugs for 300 new cases in Montserrado, Grand Bassa, Bong, and Nimba counties. Rehabilitating certain water pipelines in Monrovia, and constructing 100 new water points and 52 new boreholes around the country.

4. Strengthening Governance and the Rule of Law

The Government, working in close collaboration with it partners, is:

Developing a comprehensive anti-corruption

- strategy.
- Developing a clear plan and timeline for constitutional and legal reform.
- Submitting legislation to establish a successor body to the Governance Reform Commission
- Establishing the Truth and Reconciliation Commission and Human Rights Commission.
 Beginning the process of removing "ghost" and absentee workers and building a smaller and more professional civil service.

The Government is committed to taking action in all of these areas. Some activities will be completed by the end of June; others will take longer but the Government is committed to taking the first critical steps by the end of June. The 150 Day Action Plan is the first phase off a long-term strategy for reconstruction and development. For the longer term, by the end of June the Government will draft an <u>interim</u> strategy for sustained poverty reduction and development based on internal analysis and initial consultations with representatives of the legislature, civil society, the private sector, and other groups. Later this year, the interim strategy will

be debated and discussed nationwide, and ideas and priorities identified from those deliberations will be incorporated into a full long-term strategy for sustained poverty reduction and development in 2007.
