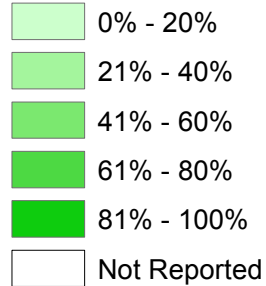

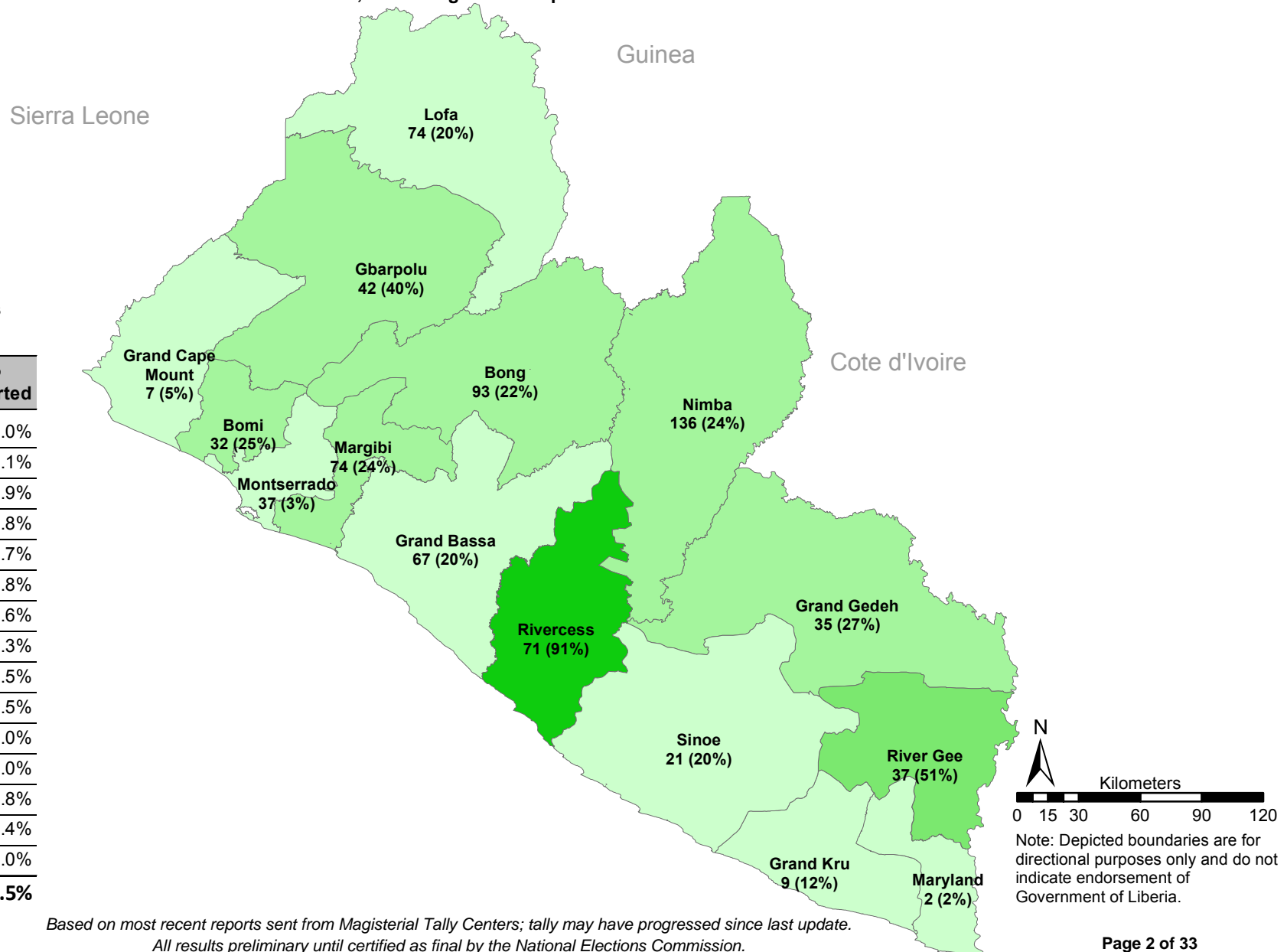

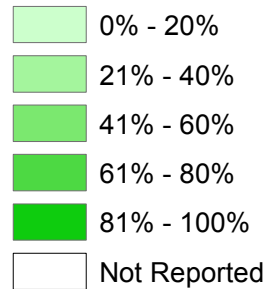


Progressive National and by County Voter's Turn Out

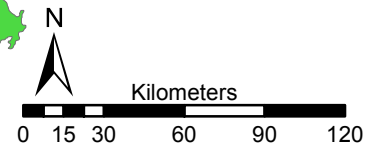
