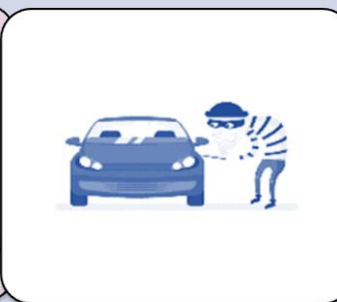

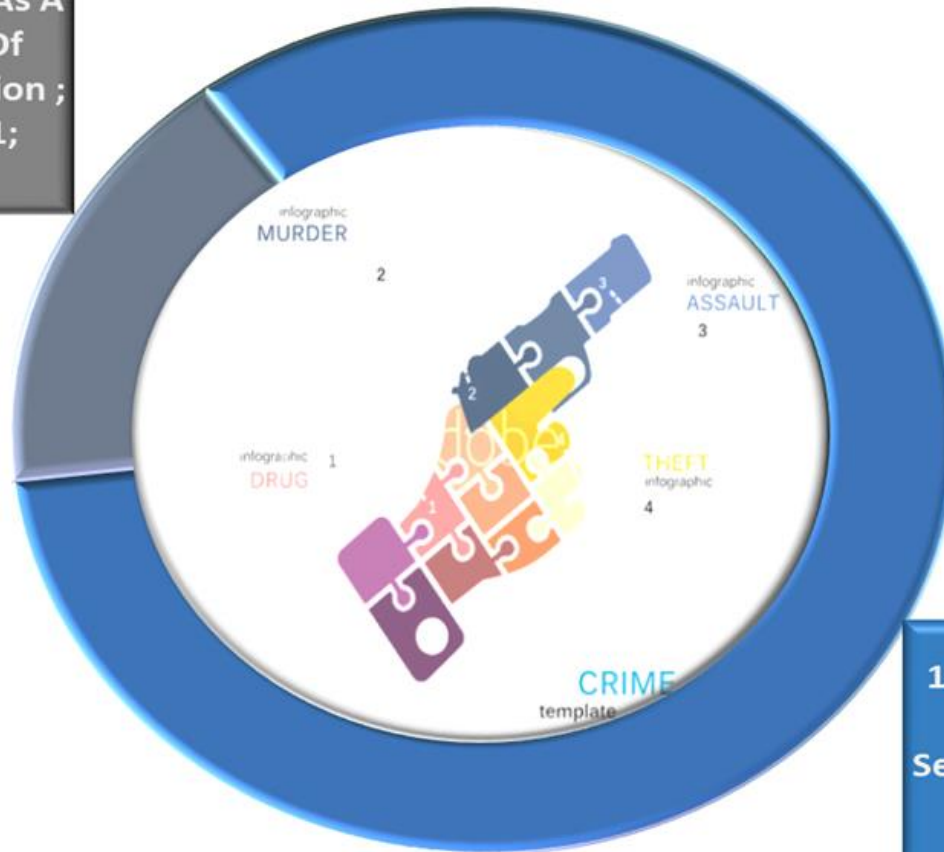

# PROPORTIONAL CONTRIBUTION OF THE 21 SERIOUS CRIMES

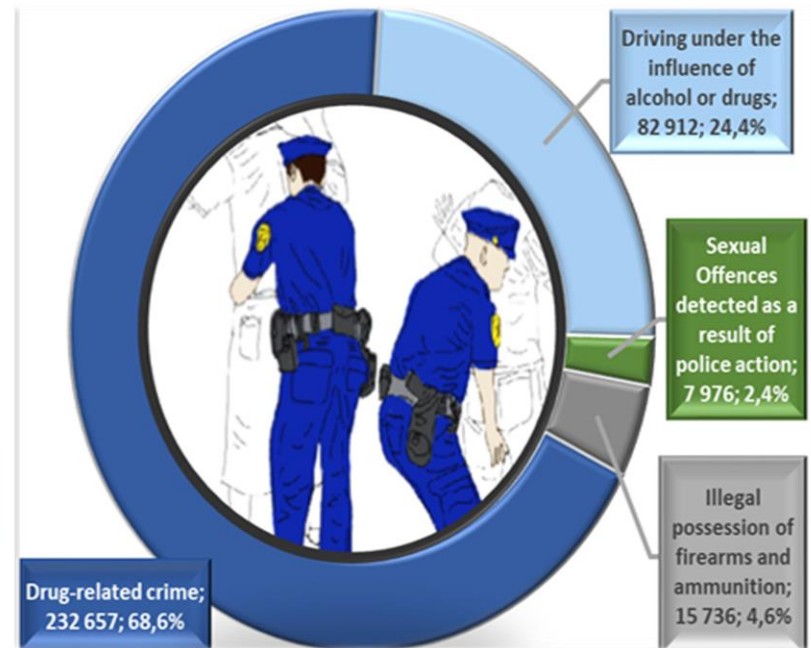
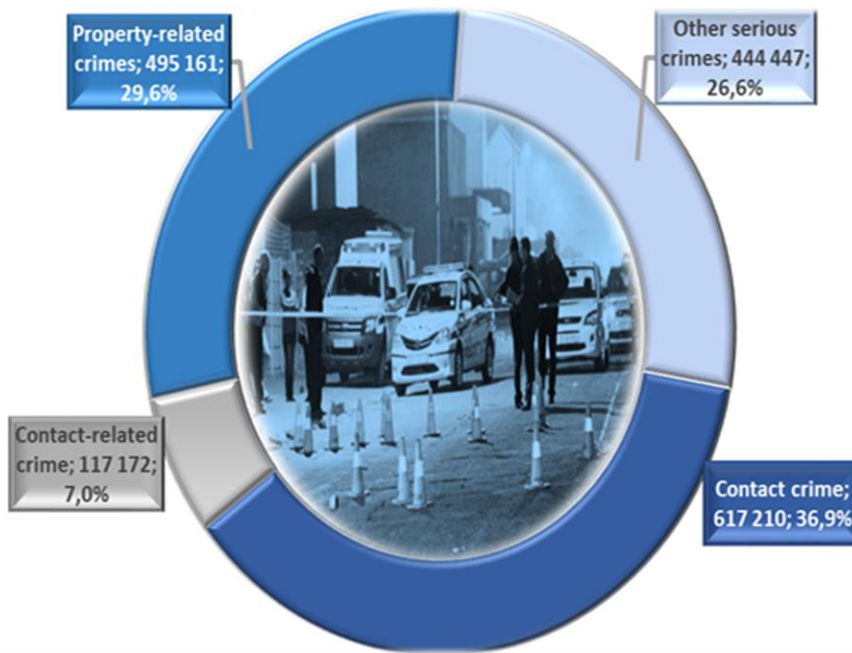

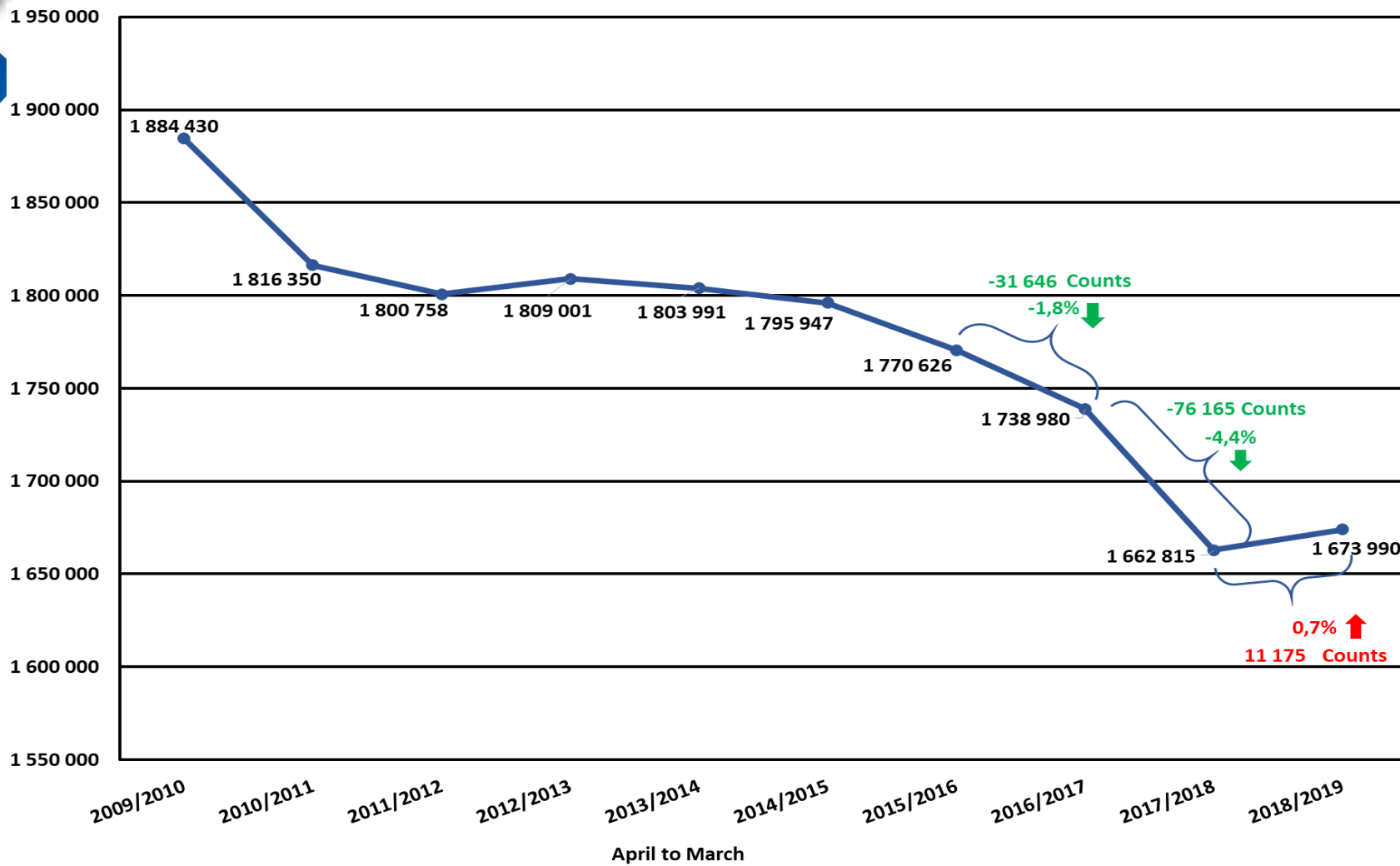

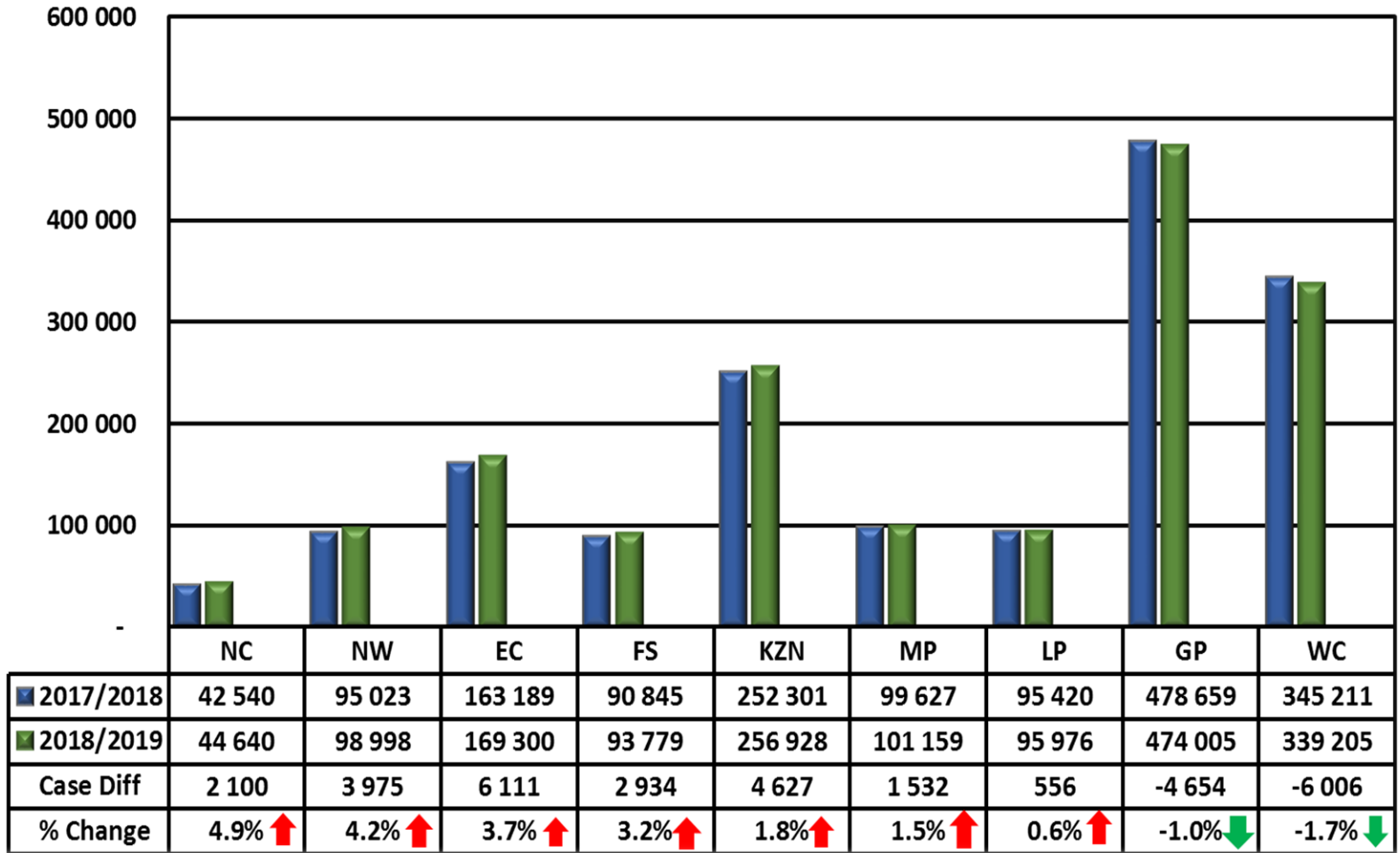

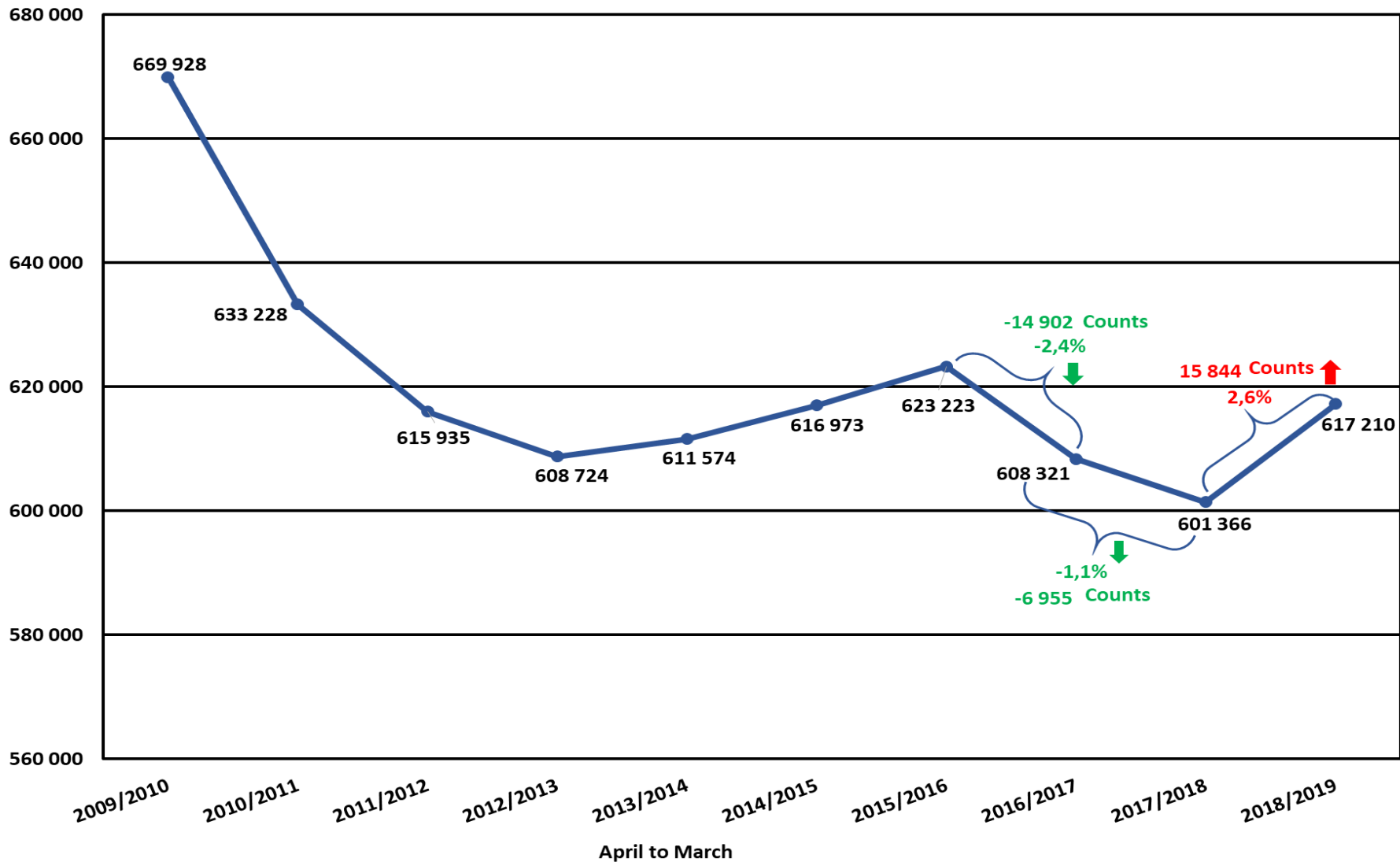

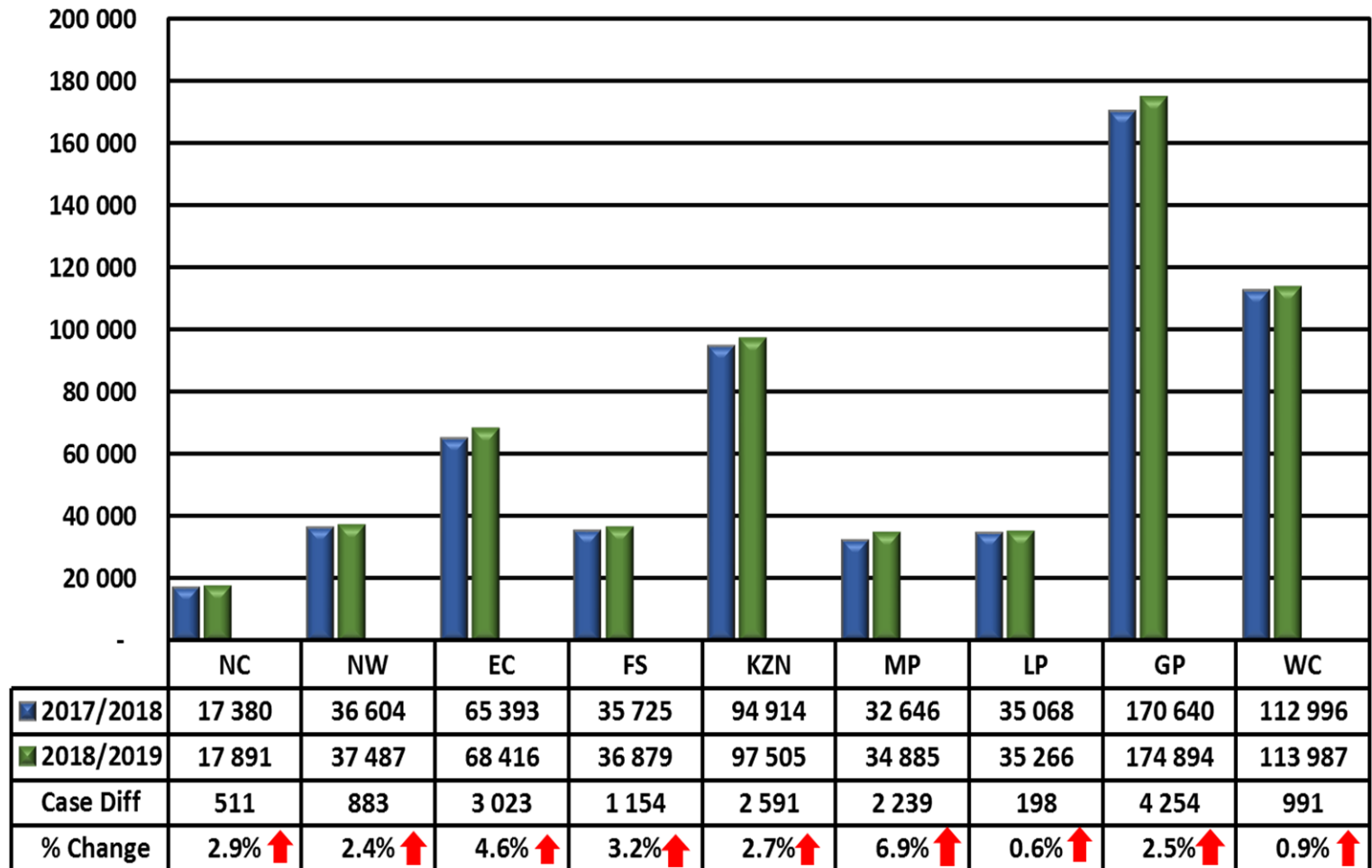

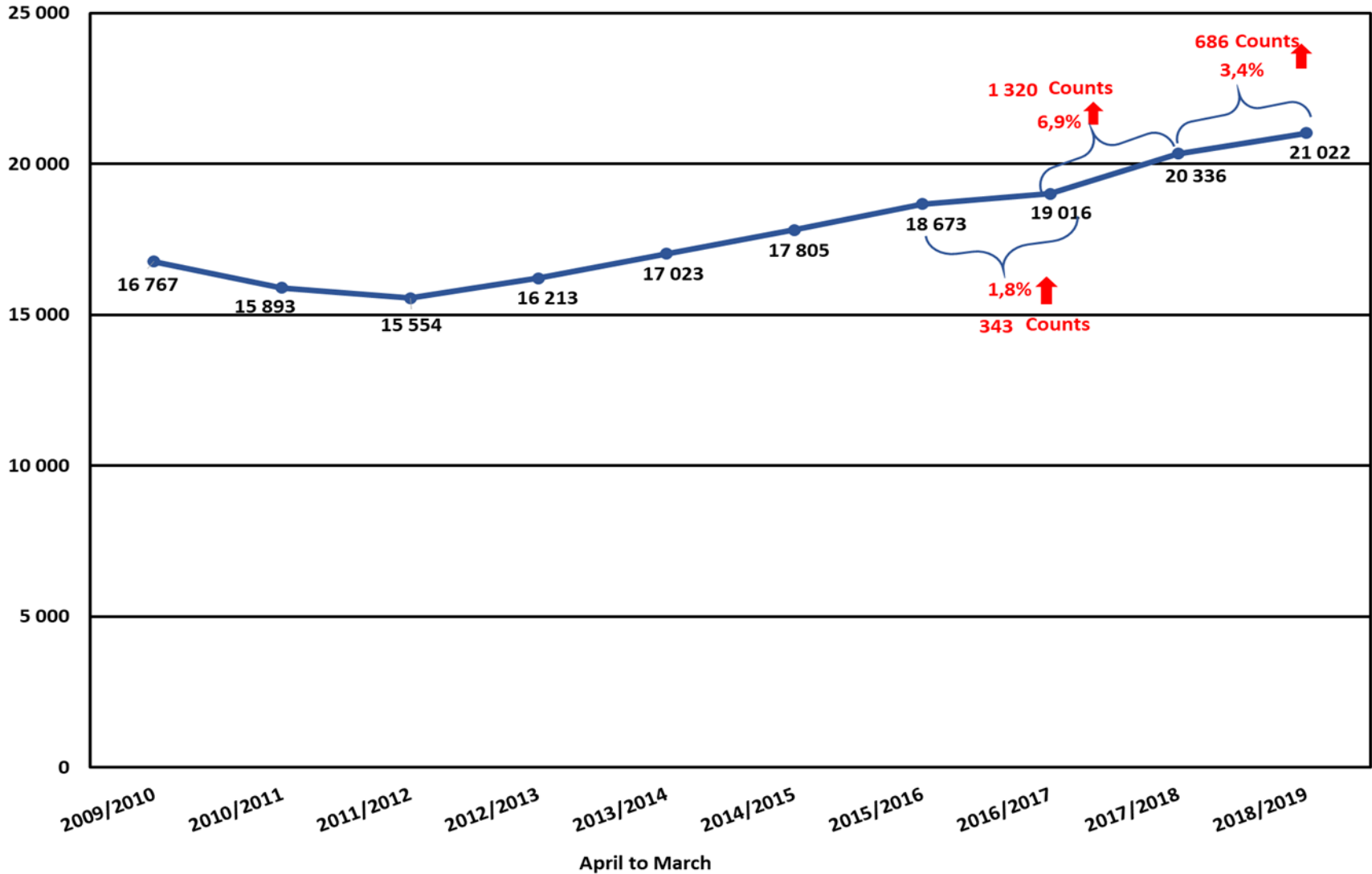

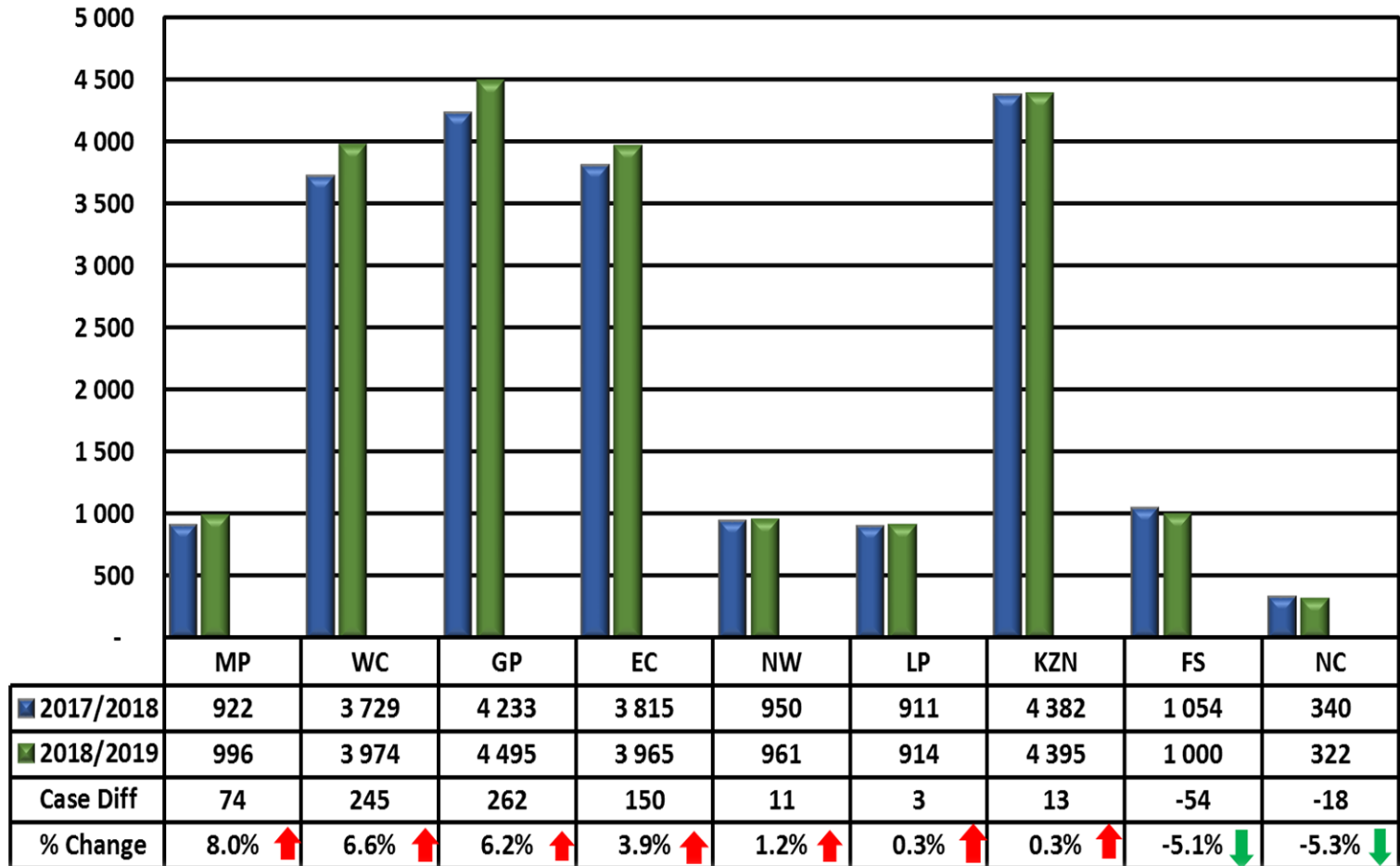

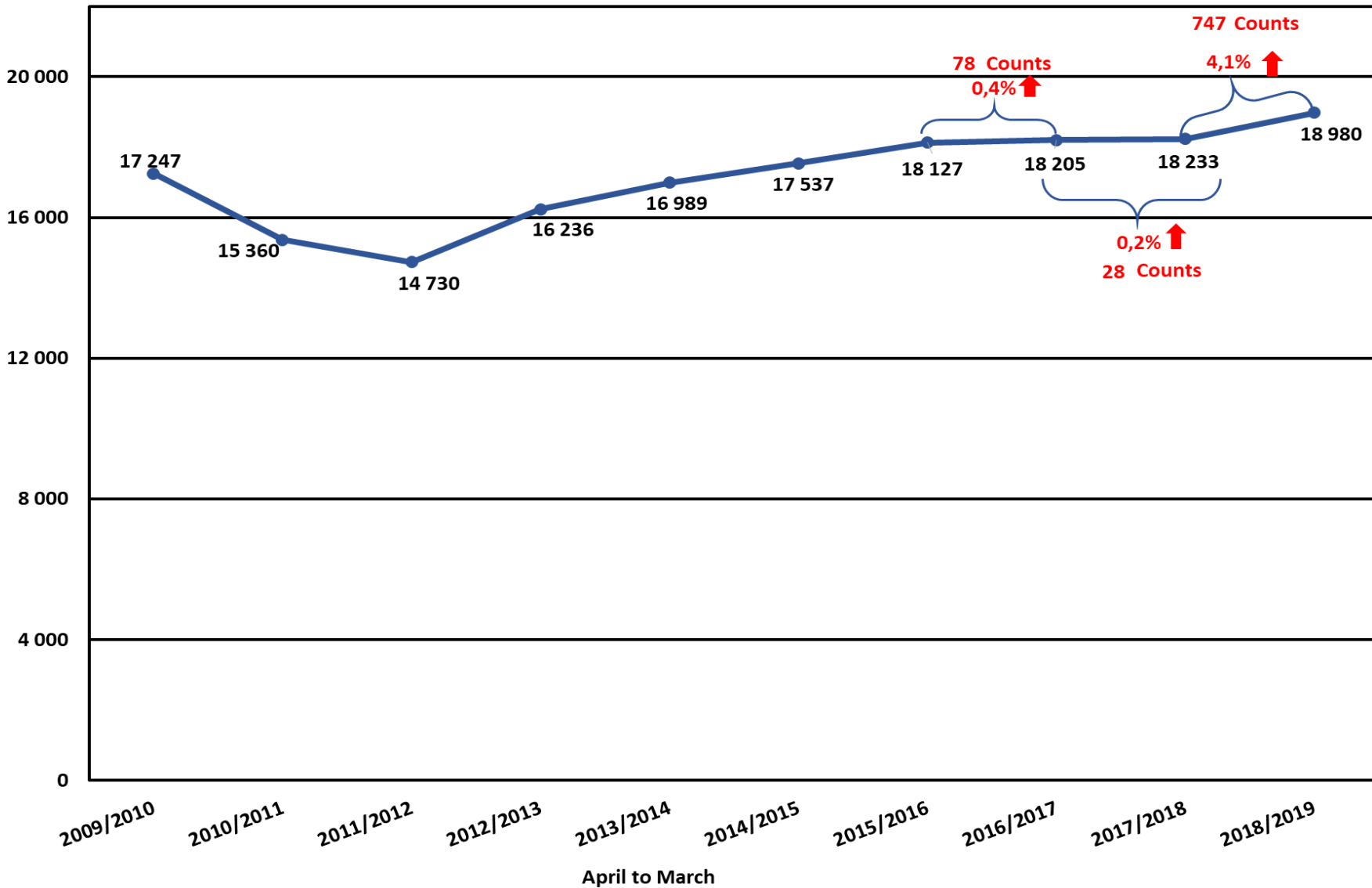

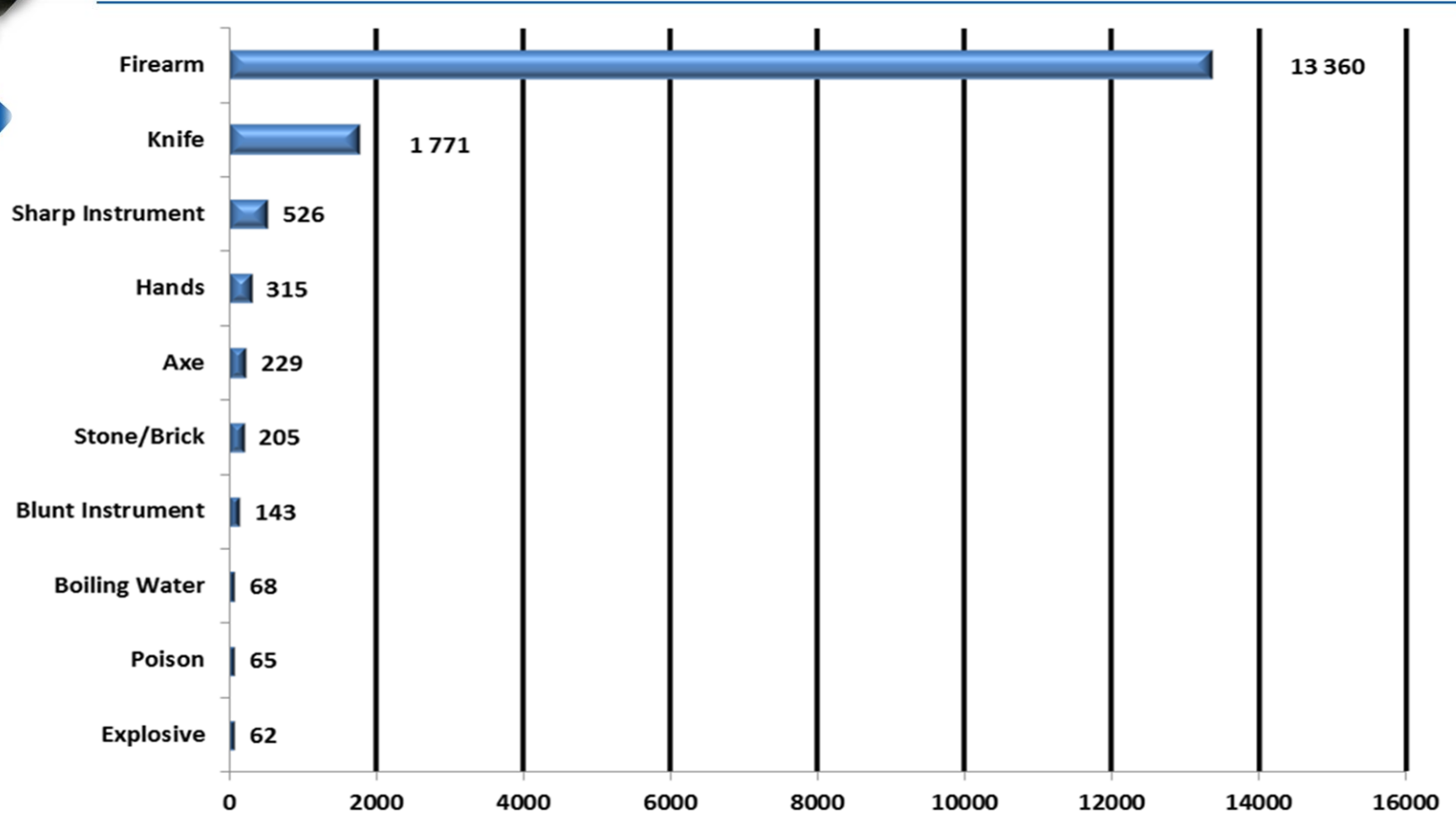
# CAUSATIVE FACTORS OF ATTEMPTED MURDER

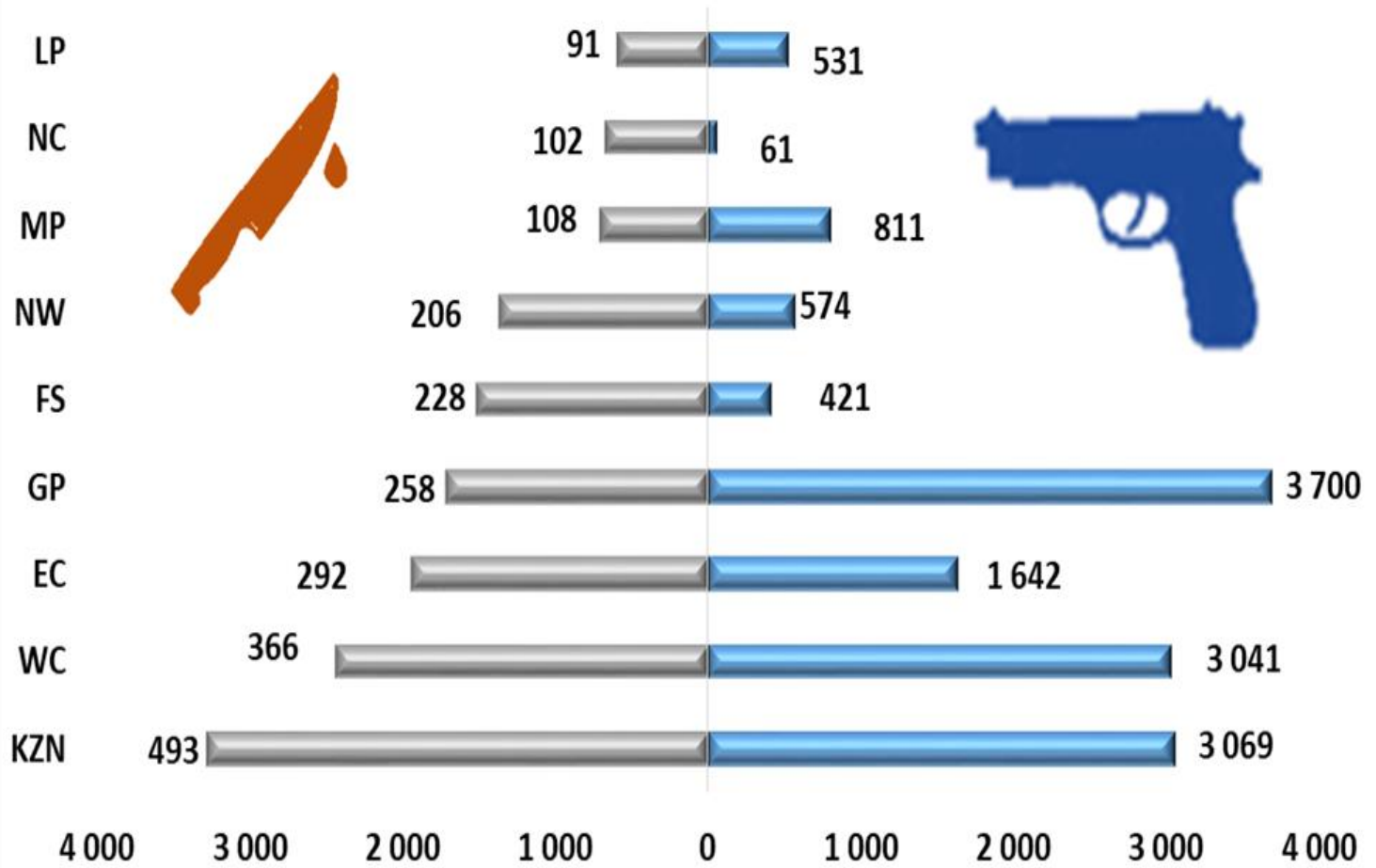
# ATTEMPTED MURDER: INSTRUMENTS USED



Firearms and knives/sharp instruments were the two highest used to commit attempted murder.

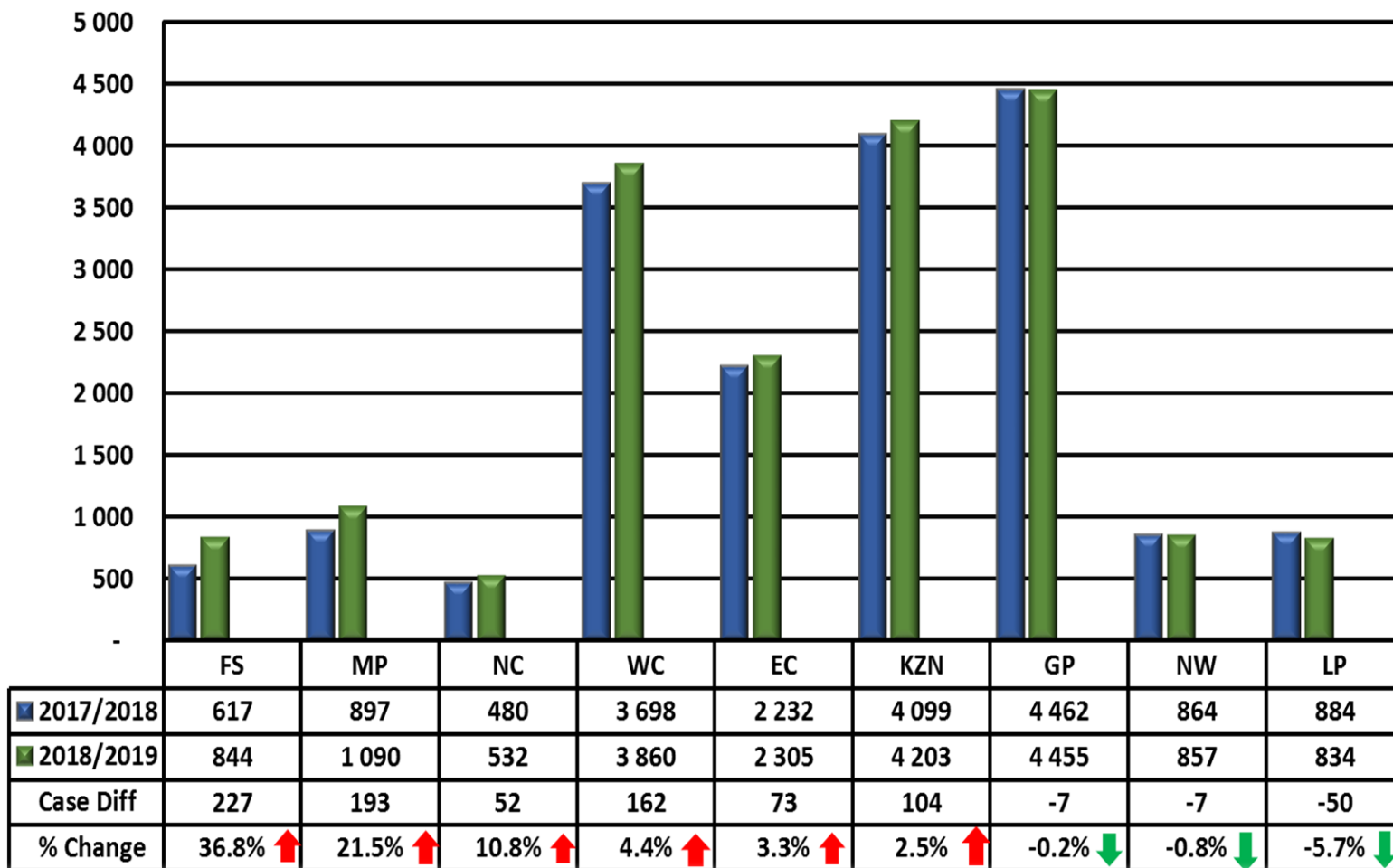


# FIREARMS VS KNIFES/SHARP INSTRUMENTS USED: PROVINCIAL OVERVIEW

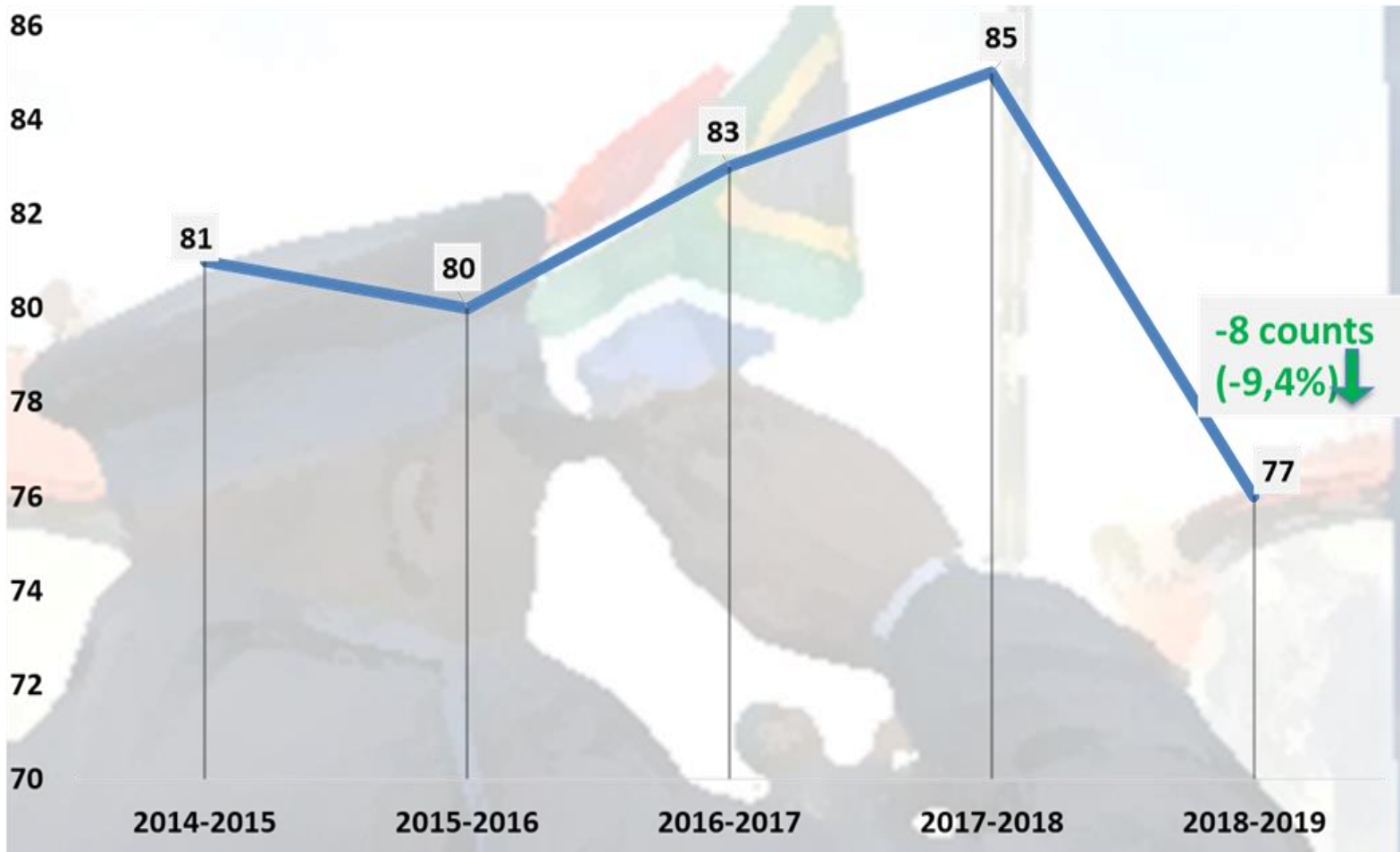

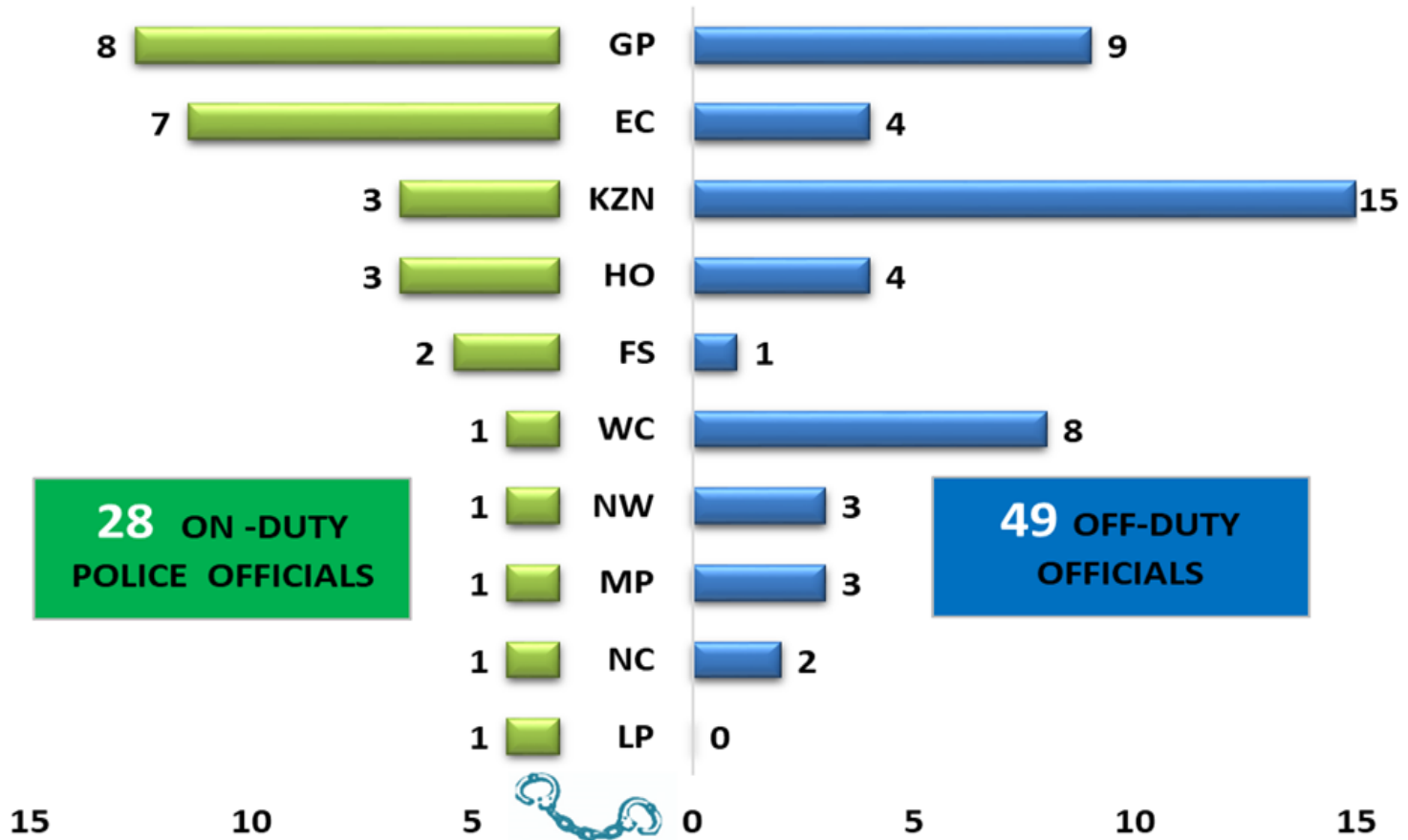

# MURDER OF MEMBERS OF THE POLICE SERVICE: TREND OVER FIVE YEARS



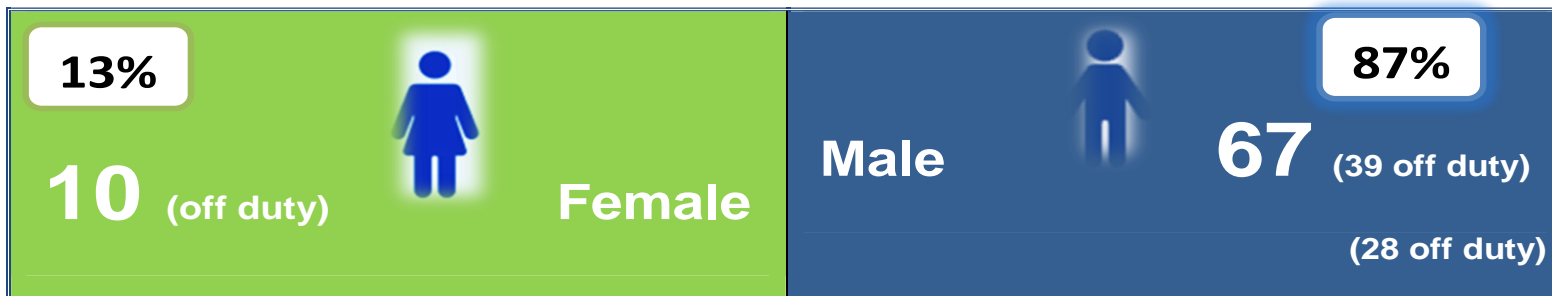


# MURDER OF MEMBERS OF THE POLICE SERVICE: PROVINCIAL DISTRIBUTION

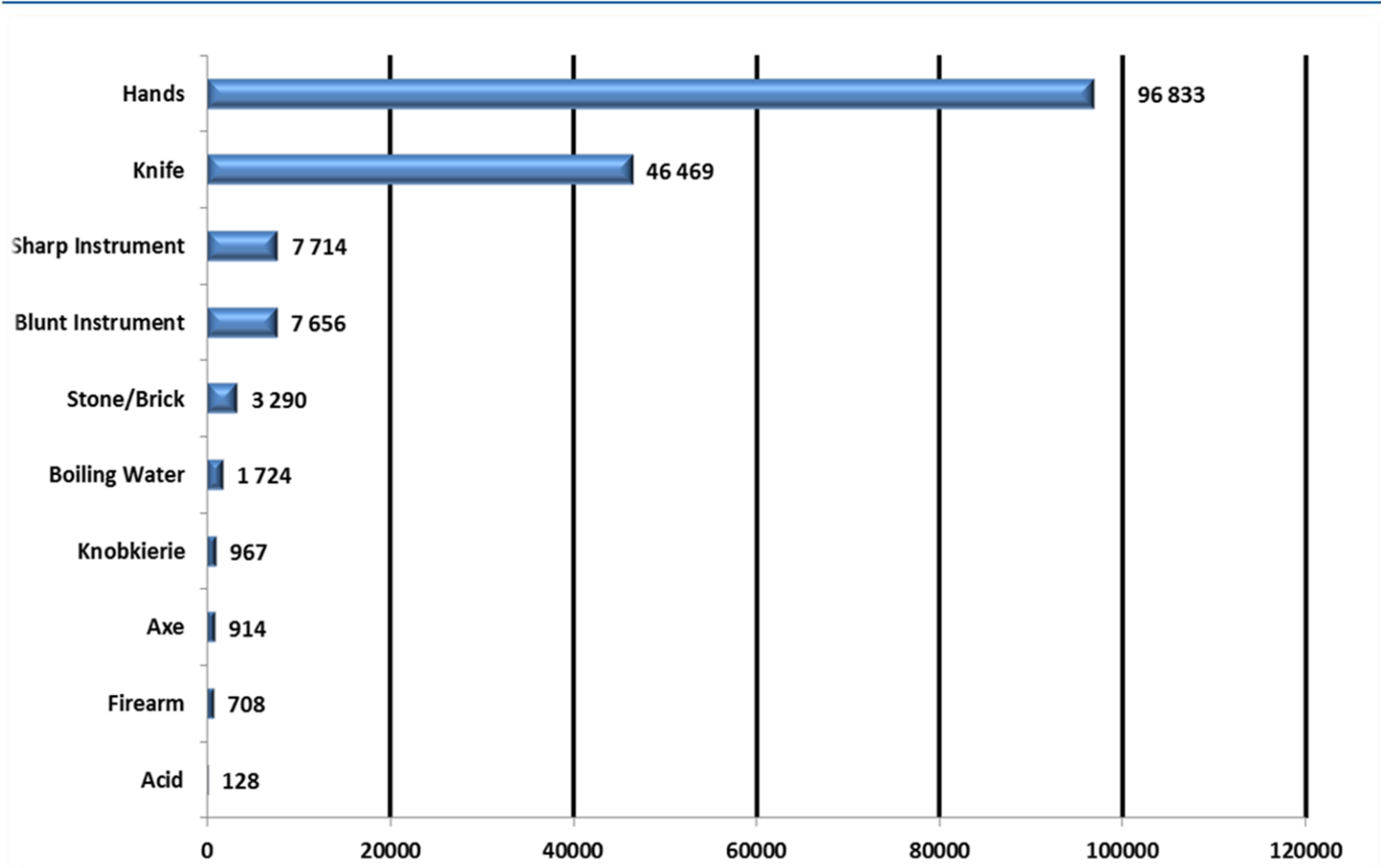


# ASSAULT WITH THE INTENT TO INFLICT GRIVIOUS BODILY HARM: TREND OVER TEN-YEARS

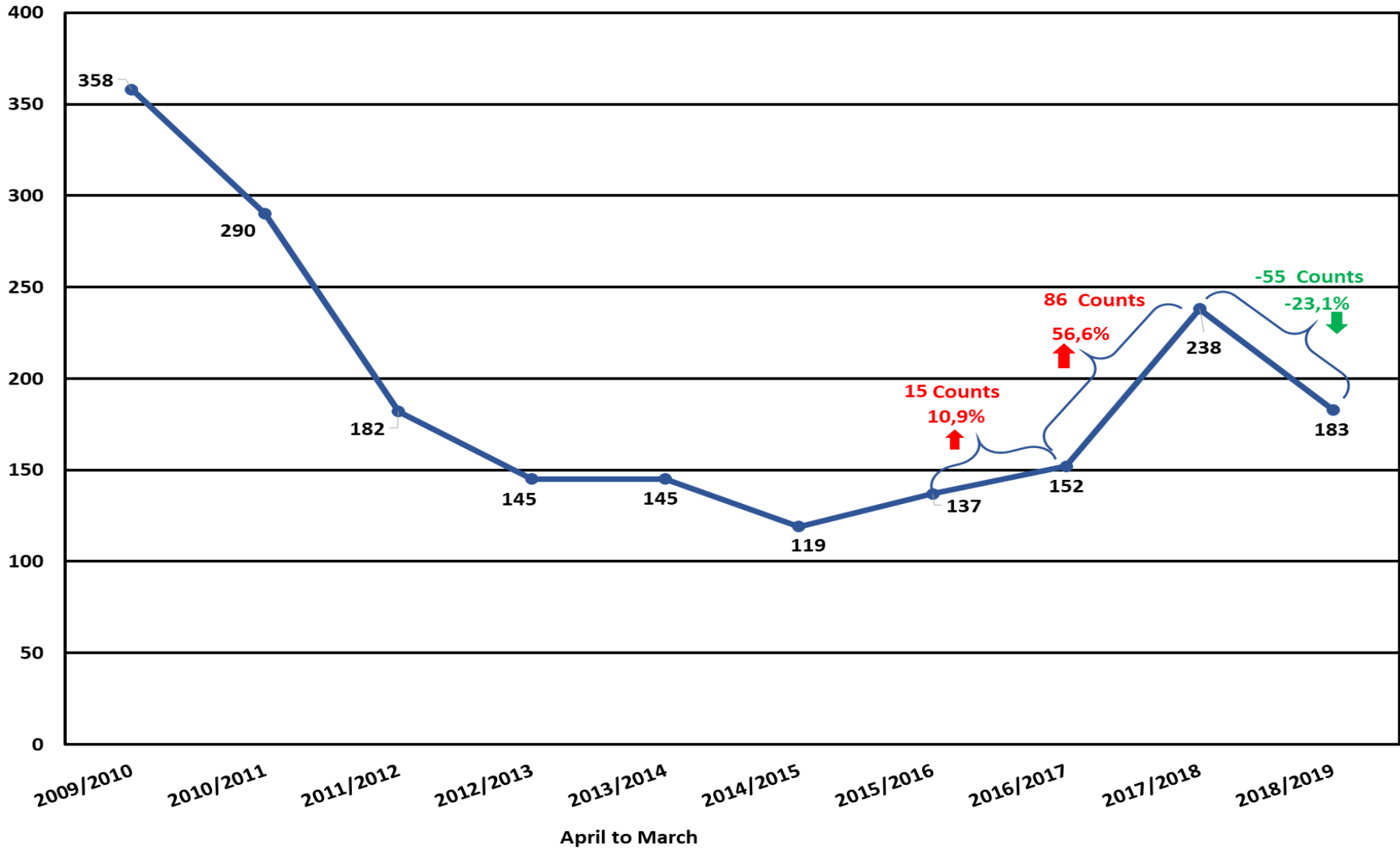

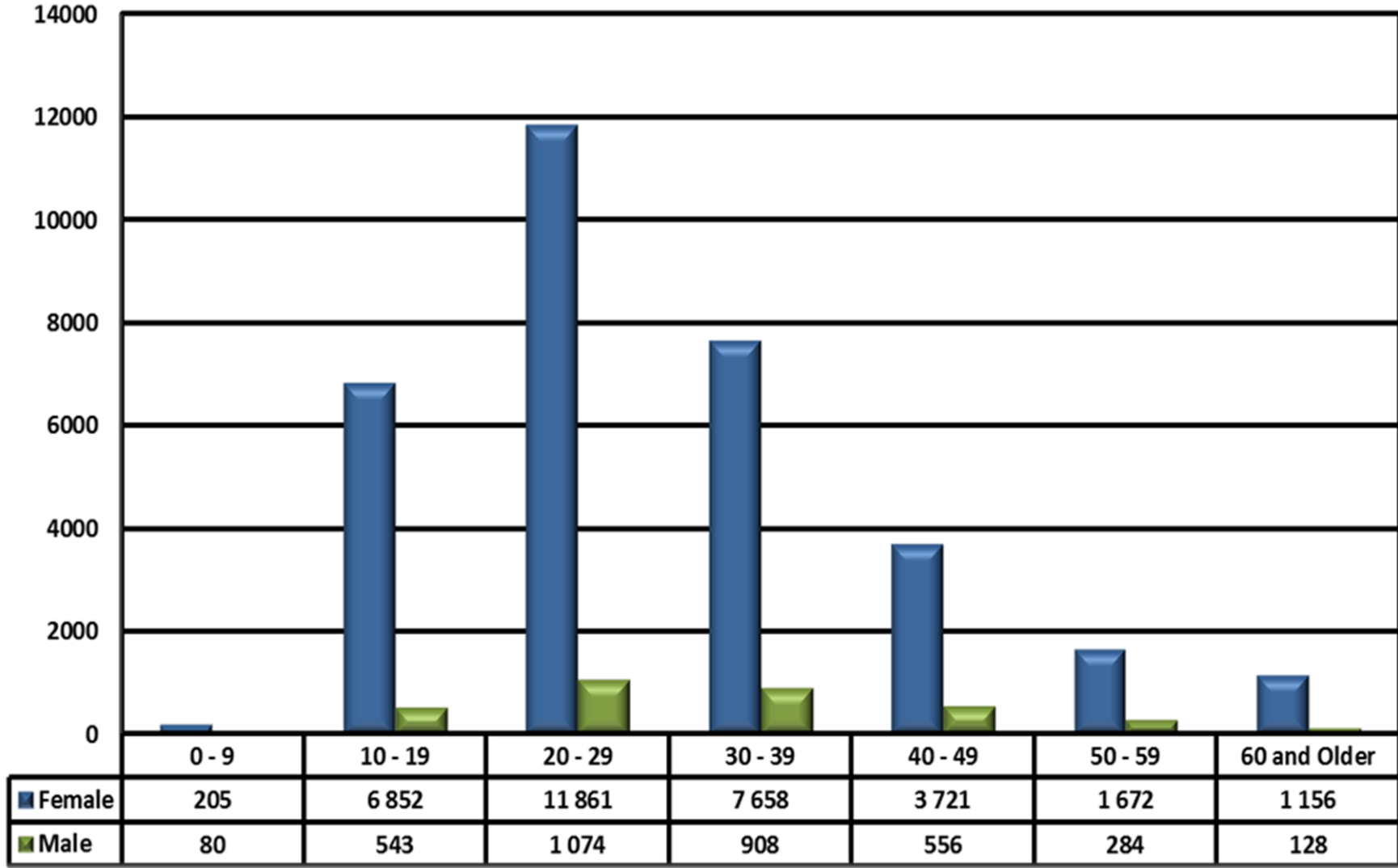


# RAPE: GENDER AS PER PROVINCE

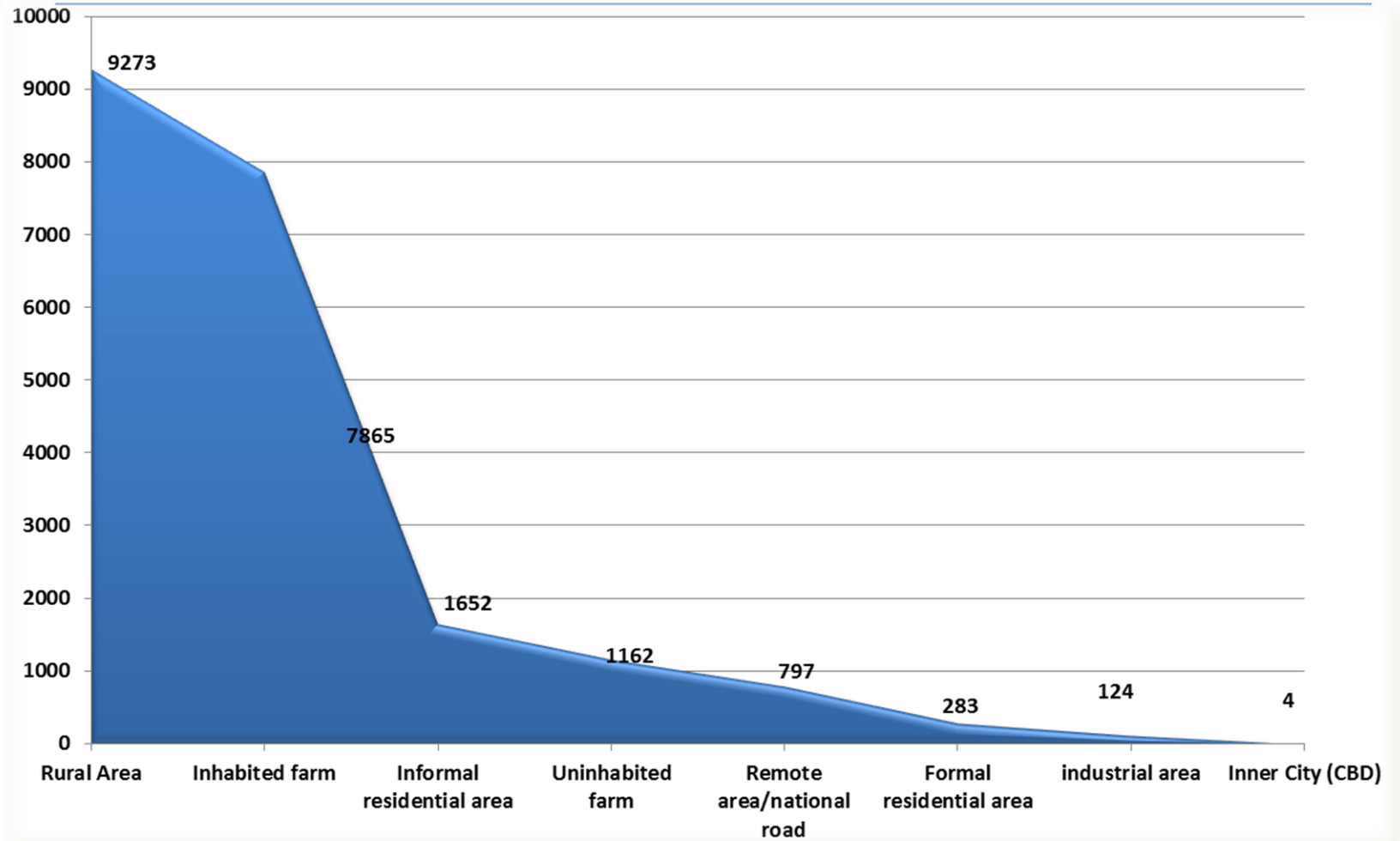

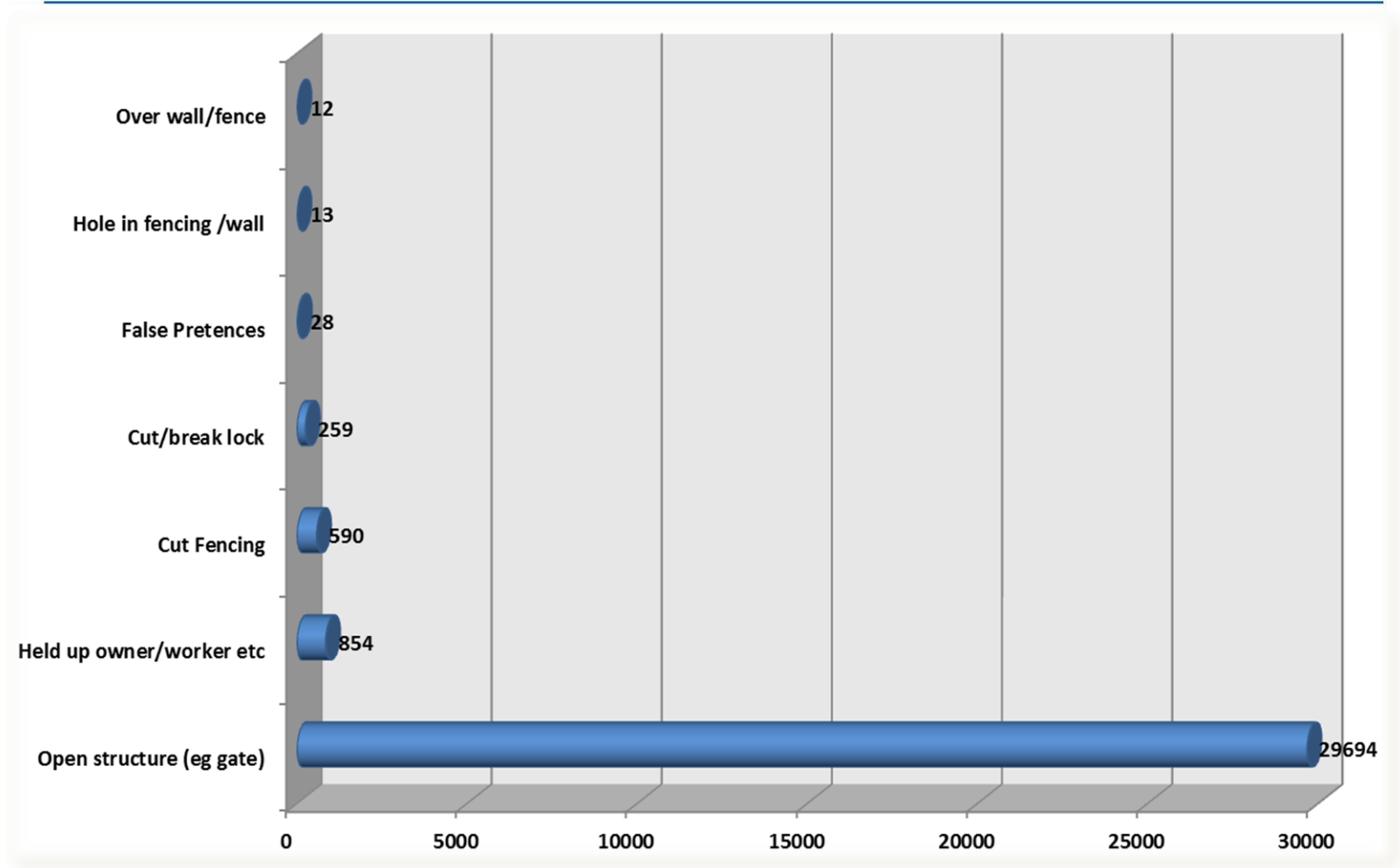

- ii) drug-related crimes,
- iii) driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, and
- iv) sexual offences detected as a result of police action.



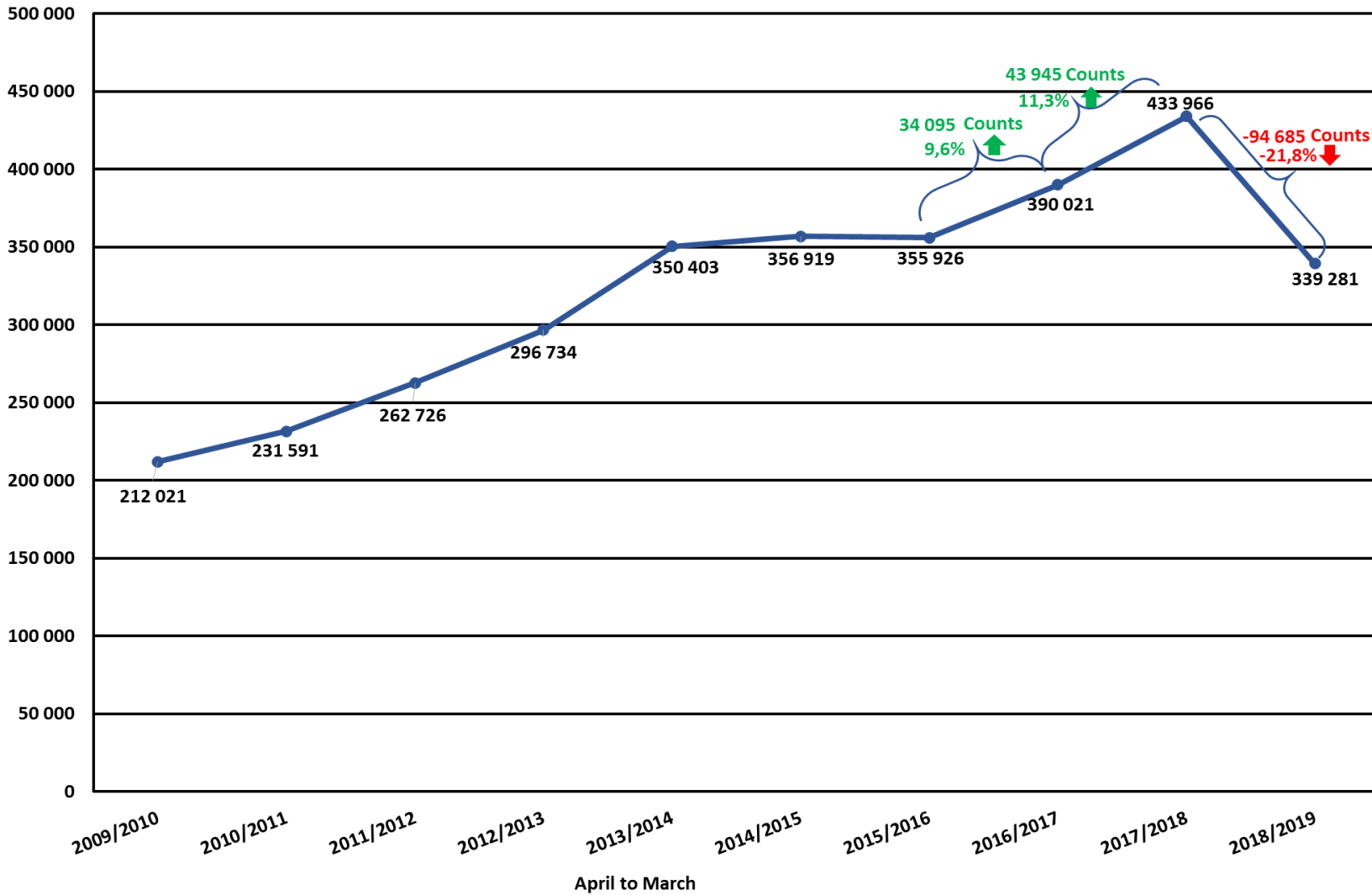

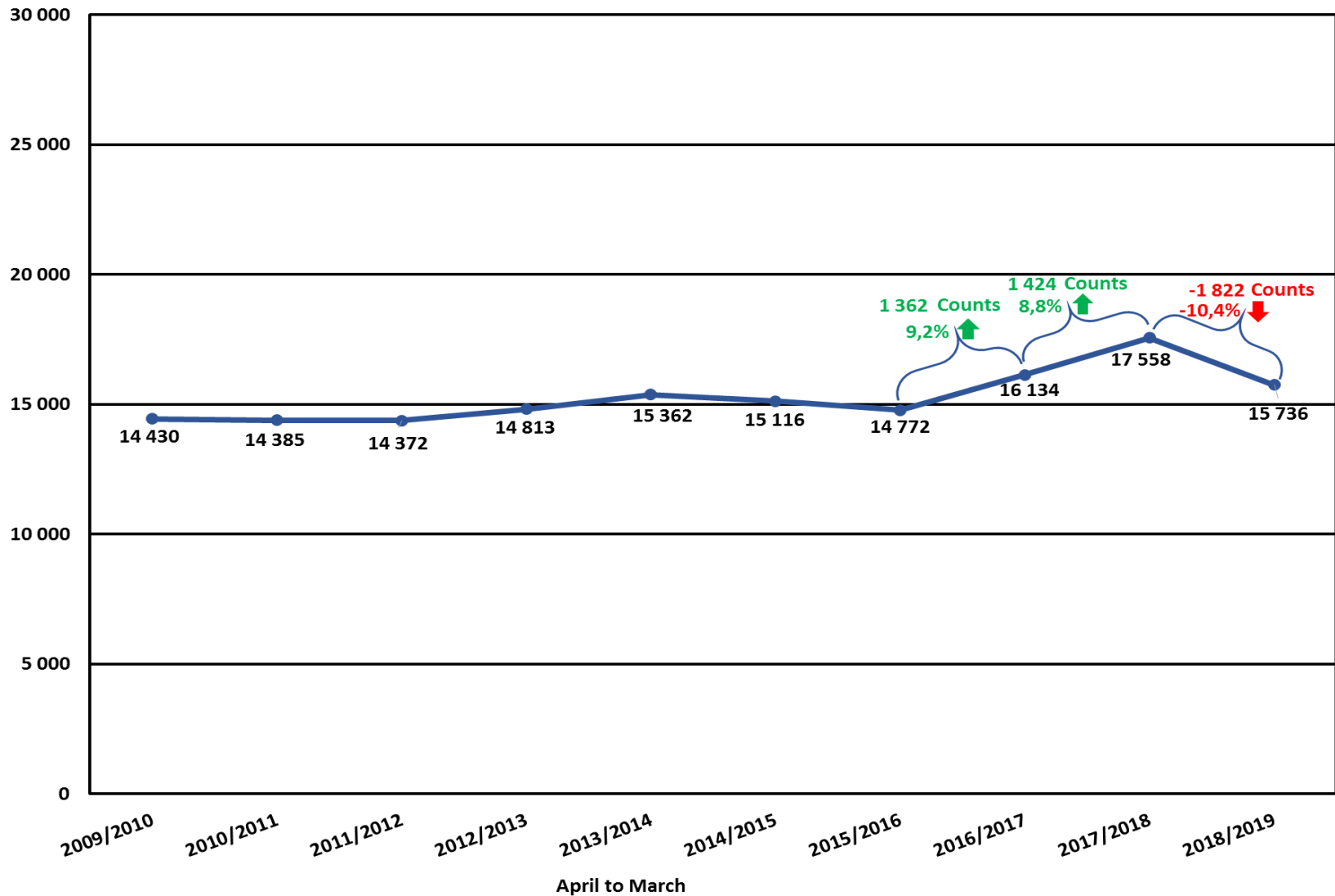

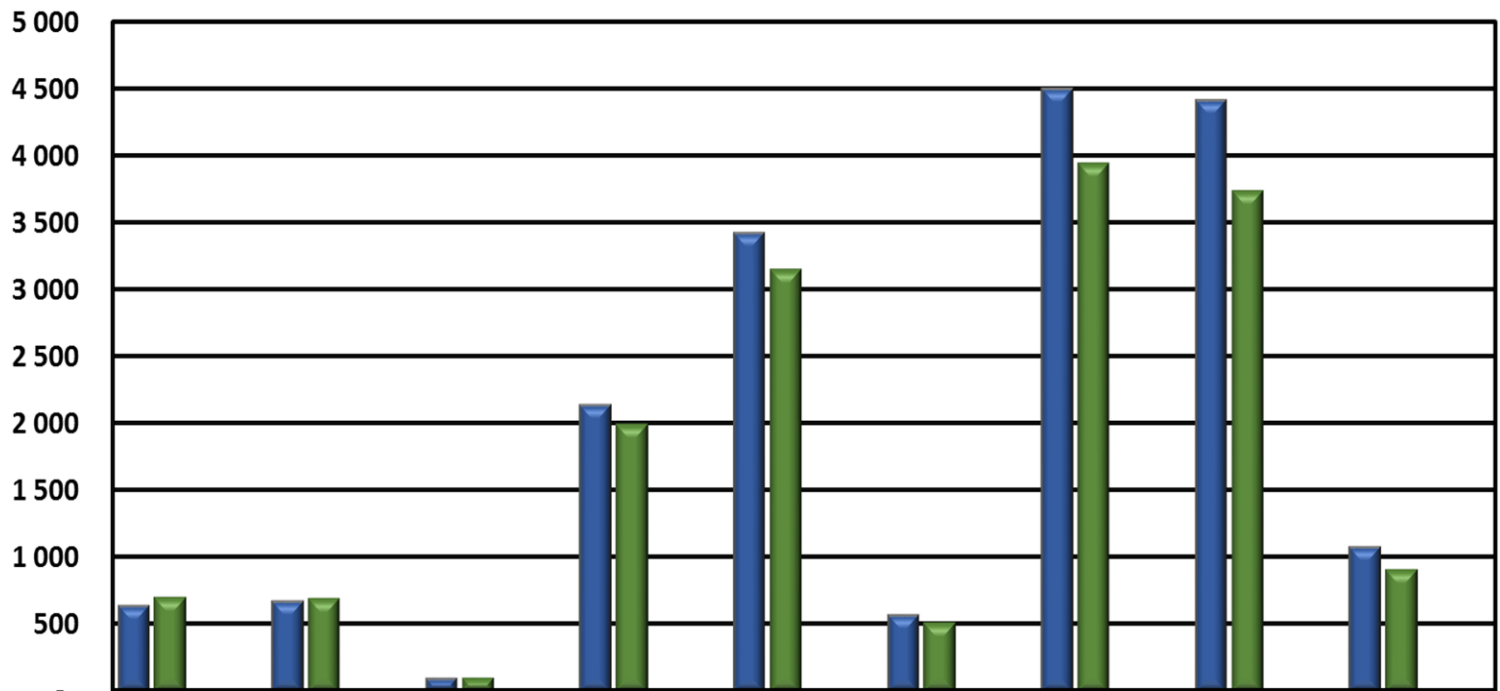

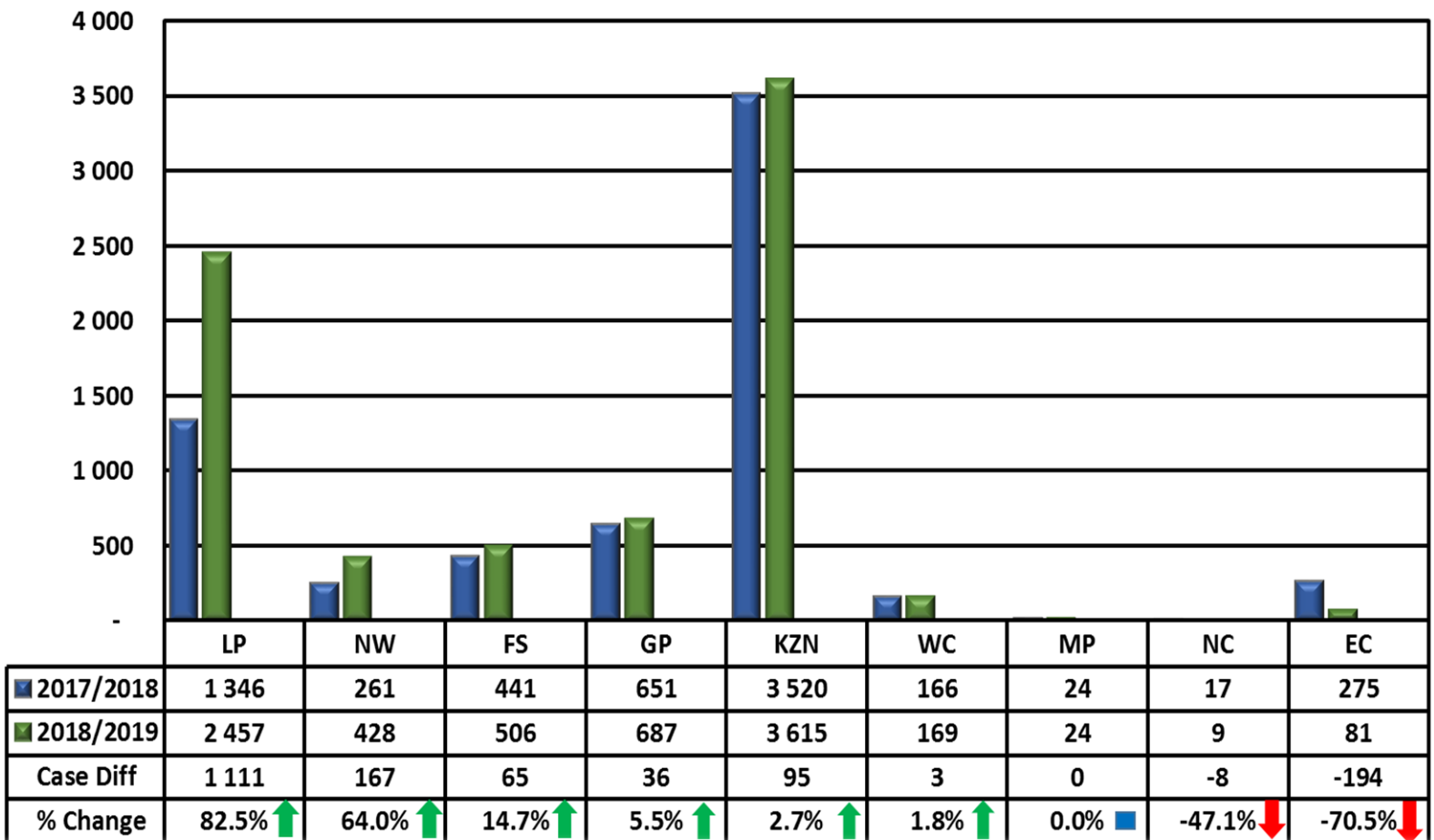

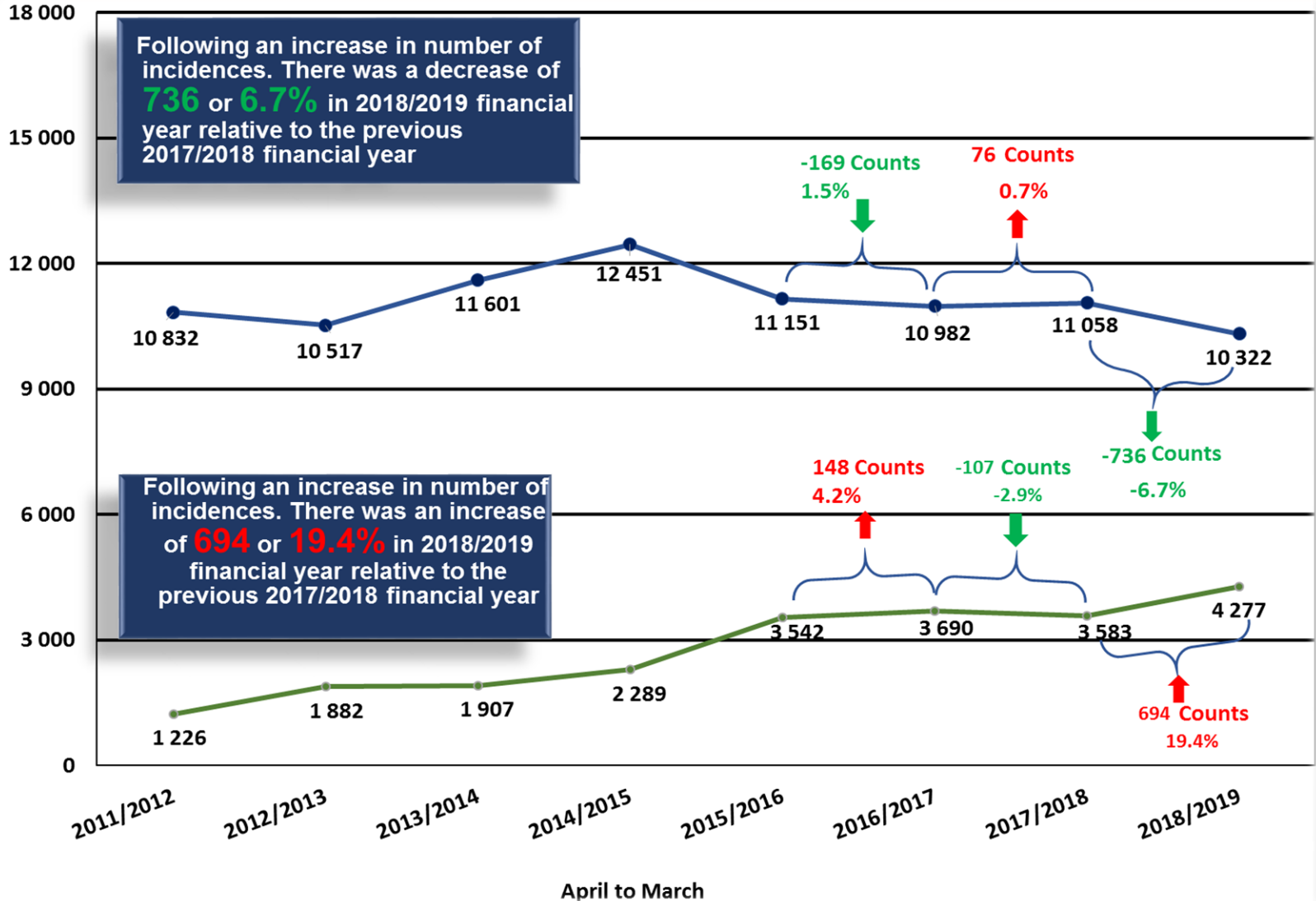

# PUBLIC ORDER INCIDENTS (UNREST-RELATED AND PEACEFUL): TREND OVER EIGHT YEARS

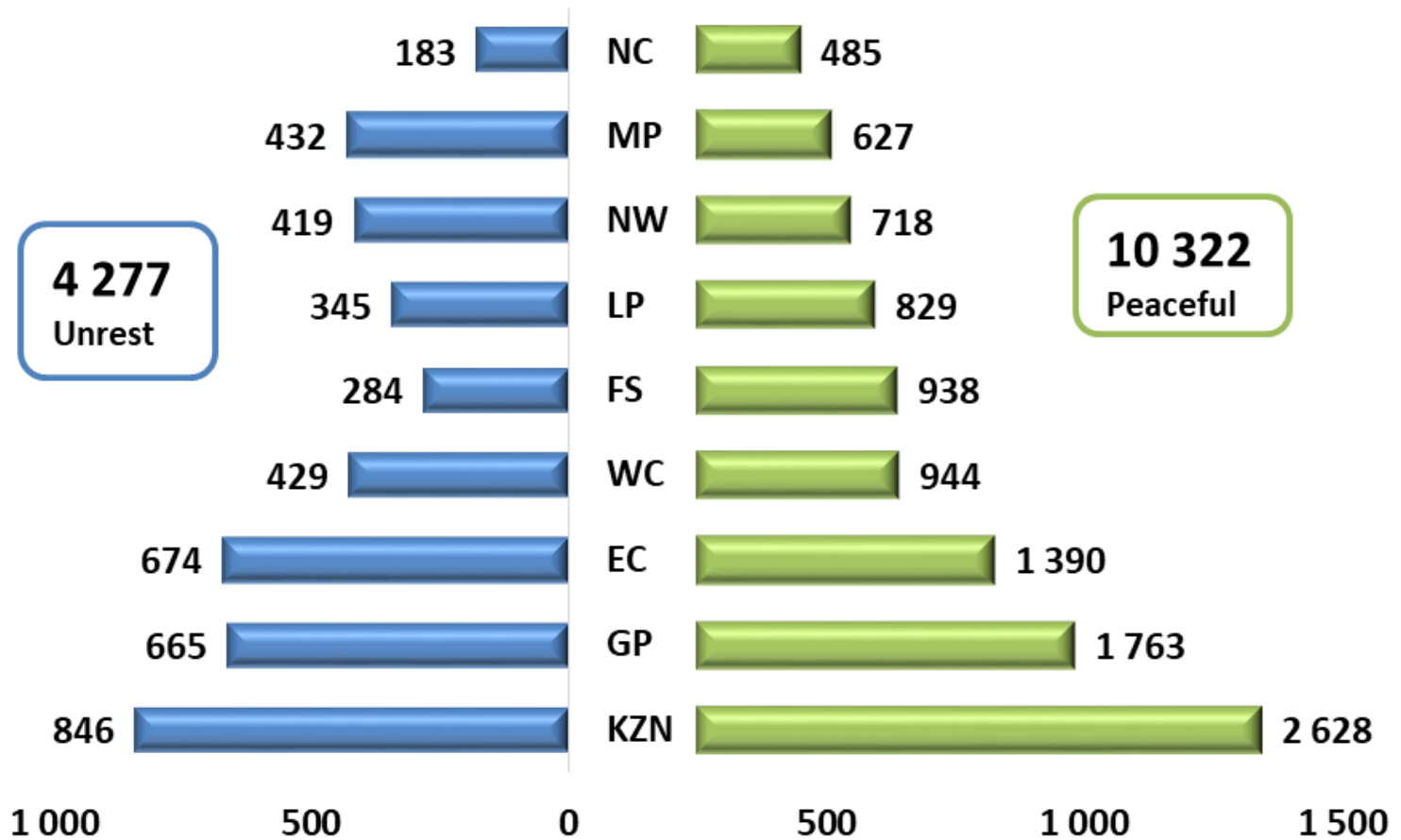

# PUBLIC ORDER INCIDENTS (UNREST-RELATED VS PEACEFUL): PROVINCIAL DISTRIBUTION





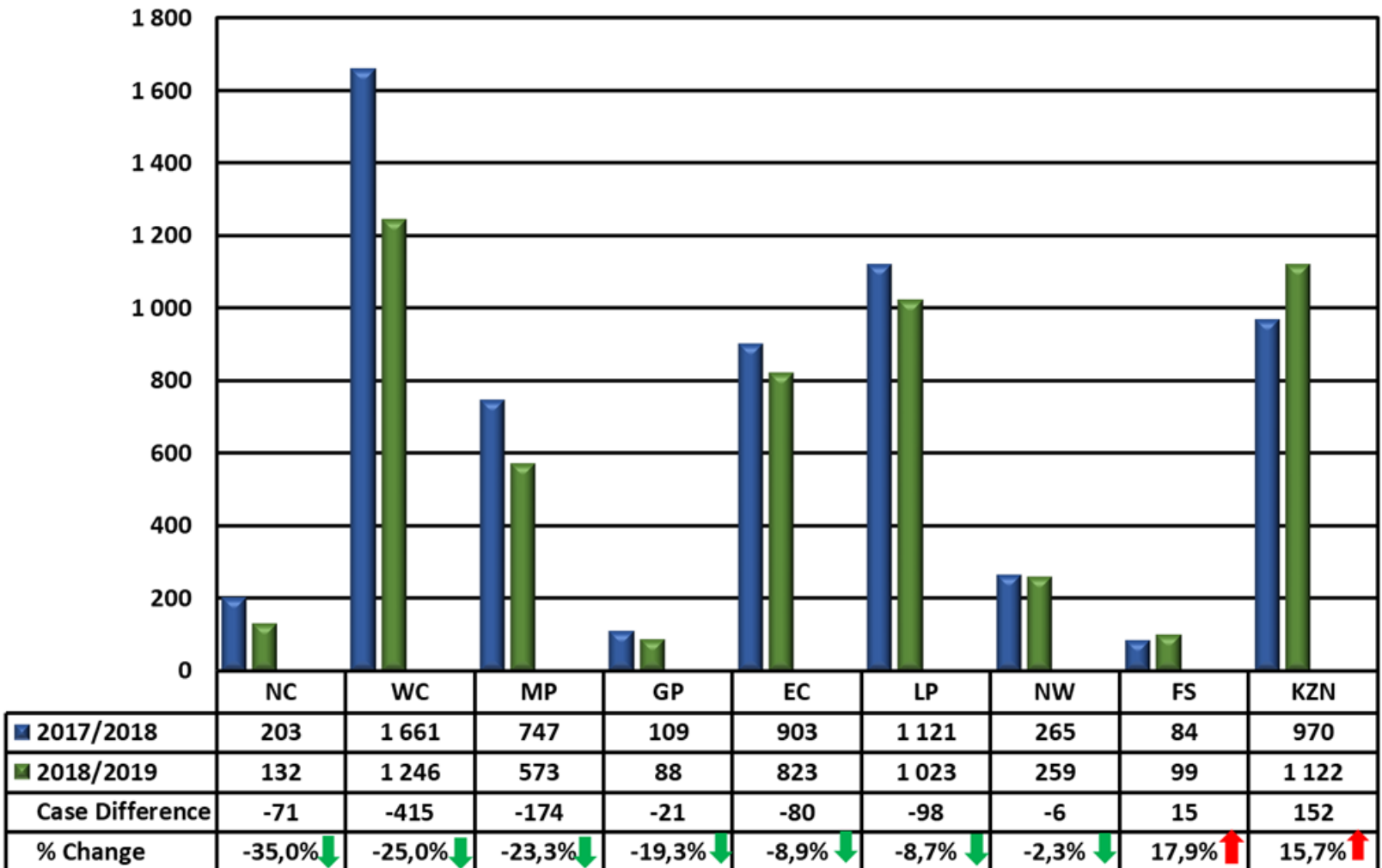
